**Resolution and other main points that came about in Bashir's
meeting of Oct. 11th 2015**

- I. President Bashir
 1. They will force the UNAMID to withdraw from Darfur at their own will before the end of the year 2015.
 2. They will harbor/ host the Egyptian Islamist by assisting, accommodating, securing and providing them with investment opportunities in Sudan.
 3. They will not chase the Islamist for the sake of appeasing president Alsisi or USA.
 4. Egyptian Islamist students are coming in large numbers to study in Khartoum.
 5. They will not respond but rather ignore all Sisi's provocative acts and continue to support the Islamist to take power from him one day when they are in their full force.
 6. They have a secret deal with Dr. Riak Machar to help him through his governors of Upper Nile states to coordinate in controlling the boarder of Upper Nile states.
 7. There are rebel fighters among the refugees in White Nile state who goes and comes back.
 8. They are the ones who decided to separate South Sudan knowing that it will not continue to hold as a state but break up into small villages after independence.
 9. Raise money to establish a trust fund with an aim to compensate the families of the victims of Darfur war crisis and manipulate them to instead ask ICC to drop the case against Bashir
- II. Al- amin Baraka – Governor West Kordufan, instilling spirit of mobilizing the Missirya to fight against South Sudan in Abyei.
- III. Ali Ahmed- Red Sea Governor,
They stored the radioactive materials at Jebal Um Ali for purposes of producing bombs and missiles for the air force.
- IV. Adam Alfaki – Governor of South Darfur,
They worked to mislead the civilians to rig the April 2016 Administrative referendum for Darfur
 10. Tacit approval to enable ISIL Mujahidin cross into Libya
 11. Reject on the idea of holding constitutional conference or consideration to the particularity of any area in Sudan, (autonomy) means determination to continue the war
 12. Declaration of general mobilization and effort to be exerted to win the public opinion and prepare them to accept and support the dry season offensive.

V. General security situation in Sudan in light of the report

1. Halayib and Shalatin occupied by Egypt, Human trafficking and weapons smuggling across the border (security measures have been taken to control the crossing points to Egypt)
 2. Fashaga area occupied by Ethiopia and Ethiopians militias killing Sudanese farmers in Fashaga, they doubt the attacks are deliberately organized by the Ethiopian side to lead Sudan into confrontation with Ethiopia.
 3. Eritrean boarder human trafficking and smuggling of goods (troops have been deployed along the border area)
 4. Libya border; there is human trafficking, smuggling of weapons, and ISIS crossing the border to Libya
 5. Fighters among South Sudan refugee go to South Sudan and come back White Nile state.
 6. Massiriya tribes of west kordofan state mobilized to fight against South Sudan in Abyei
 7. There is a tribal fighting between the Arab tribes in Darfur, West Kordofan and Khartoum state (Jumu- Eya and Hawawiir tribes)
 8. Northern State Dams area and Manasir.
 9. Civil war raging in South Kordofan, Blue Nile and Darfur States.
- SAF and other security forces are over stretched to curb the rebellion, cover and secure the long borderlines all over, disarm the tribes etc.

- 2- The President of the Republic and Chairman of the NCP welcomed the Governors to the meeting.

3- Federal Affairs Minister presented the directives intended to govern the function of the States Governors.

4- Agenda:

- a- Governors to report on security and political situations in their respective states plus any progress achieved in the implementation of the State Reform Charter.
- b- Comment / reflection/reaction of the President to/on the Governors Reports.
- c- Recommendations and resolutions.
- d- Governors are to present verbal summary of their reports and hand over the written reports to the secretariat.

~ Merghani Salih – Gedarif State Governor:

There are incursions conducted by the Ethiopian Militias along Sudan/ Ethiopian border attacking farmers at the Fashaga area which had led to failure of the agricultural production this year. We sent Police and PDF to protect the farmers. We think these attacks are organized by the Ethiopian side, and the situation may develop into an open war. We are request the leadership to hold a meeting with the Ethiopian authorities to contain this situation. In regards to the implementation of the State Reform Charter, we have revised all government plans and programs to conform to it. We also formed committees to reorganize the party and recruit more students to the membership of the NCP. We mobilized the youth and women to prepare food for the fighters in the coming dry season military offensive/operations. We are also encouraging the youth to enlist by joining the military service, PDF, National Service and Rapid Support Forces (RSF).

~ Hussen Yasin – Blue Nile State Governor:

My State is the most threatened state by the rebels who are currently based at a distance of 35 Kilometers away from Damazin where there are vital installations. Crushing and chasing the rebels for good is a must. In order to achieve this goal we must coordinate with Dr. Riak Machar *Governors of Upper Nile States in return of access to development*

~ Al-Daw Al-Mahi – Sinnar State Governor:

Our State is the most stable one. We have partnership with the National Unity Political Parties and encouraged them to support the National Dialogue process and help us in the resettlement

of the Arab nomads who returned from South Sudan. We are implementing the State Reform Charter. We also prepared the people of the State to support the war effort by men and finances. In addition to that we started reorganizing the NCP with the aim to correct the bad image/experience we have had during the last elections. The membership of the Islamic Movement is increasing and the training of the cadre and future leaders is continuing.

~ Ahmed Harun – North Kordofan Governor:

The State Reform Charter is a priority to us. We have taken measures to secure all the boundaries of the State. We managed to put in place a very efficient reporting system to avoid Um-Ruwaba and Rahad experience. We connected the various localities with advanced communication equipments that can't be affected by network failure in case of any incident.

~ Abu-Al-Gasim Al-Amin Baraka – West Kordofan State Governor:

We managed to reconcile the belligerent Misiriya clans by paying most of the blood money and left the remaining part to be paid by the Misiriya Leader Salih Al-Salluha. We mobilized them against the rebel movements and promised an incentive to any tribal chief who succeed to bring the members of his tribe back to government controlled areas. We asked them to participate in the defense of the southern border of the State, fight for their land in Abiyei and the rebellion in South Kordofan. To do that, they should join the RSF.

We promised jobs for their sons in the oil producing companies provided that, they are able to participate in the protection of all oil exploration companies and their engineers. We shall pay compensation to any tribe for oil discovered in its' land.

~ Mohammed Tahir Eila – Gezira State Governor:

We have prepared all the plans to face the challenges of the coming phase including coordination with the National Unity Parties in order to make the National Dialogue a success, rescue Gezira Scheme, open training camps for fighters and instill in their minds the spirit of Jihad and martyrdom, plus efforts to render services and boost security in the State.

~ Mohammed Hamid Al-Balla – River Nile State Governor:

Our main problem lies in the fifth columnist political parties (Communist and Umma) who worked to instigate the Manasiir of the Dams Areas to escalate the conflict, but they are put under control. Anyone who is working to destabilize the State, we shall deal with him harshly. We are working to legalize the mining of gold. We started to implement the Reform Charter. All the military Barracks are ready to move on order. I, did paid a visit to the training centers of the RSF, PDF, National Service and the Artillery unit and found an advanced kind of training taking place . We are working in full coordination with the loyal political parties. The Dialogue is the way out, but we refuse any attempt to hold the conference outside the country.

~ Ali Al-Awad – Northern State Governor:

The situation at the border with Libia is dangerous because it is used as a transit for human trafficking, smuggling of weapons and crossing point for the Mujahidiin going to join ISIL in Libia as well as our border with Egypt. The implementation of the State and party reform is going on well and the response from the side of leaders and members is positive. We have worked to build the Islamic Movement and the NCP, the National service and the PDF. We decided that services are rendered on condition that, the beneficiary has enlisted to the National service military training. Our aim is to use these forces for the establishment of an Islamic rule that will be inherited by the coming generations. We are facilitating the Arab investors and providing them with security. The loyal political parties are in complete agreement with us and we are working together to secure all the State borders and crossing points to Egypt.

~ Abdal-Hamid Musa Kasha – White Nile State Governor:

Our borders with the South are secured, and our forces are on standby. The training camps have graduated many men for RSF, SAF and the police, meanwhile the mobilization is still going on, due to the fact that our state is near to the war that is raging in the South. The number of refugees from the South is increasing on daily basis and they began to constitute a source of insecurity to the State because of polarization among them on tribal basis. There are also fighters who go to the South and come back. Generally the State is ready to counter any incursions. On top we have a force ready to move to the operation areas in South Kordofan. We have also created a force to defend Rawat oil field against any attack from the side of the armed movements.

~ Adam Jamma Adam –Kasala State Governor:

The reform is going on well, but the act of human trafficking still remains a major security concern in the state together with the cases of smuggling of goods that the neighboring Eritrean State Governor is/has been supervising it. Measures have been taken to crack down/curb the smuggling phenomena, but we could not succeed due to the cooperation between the smugglers and some members in regular army forces. We have trained and increased the number of forces to cover the whole border line with Eritrea. Regarding the Dialogue we are in complete understanding with the loyal parties. We have also prepared food to support the fighters in the various war fronts/ frontline

Ali Ahmed – Red Sea State Governor:

The most important to us is the problem with Egypt in Halayib and Shalatin and the accelerated Egyptianization process in them. Also there is continuous crossing of the International Waters for spying and collection of information about our strategic positions and military bases. When captured they pretend to be fishermen. In order to avoid this spying activity we moved many weapon stores to more secured places and we worked to reconstruct the missile base. Also and in coordination with the military industrial corporation we started the transportation of the Radio Active Materials containers that are liable to explode to Jabel Um-Ali with the aim to use them for making bombs and missiles for aerial bombardment and artillery shelling. Our relation with the political parties is good and we agree on the dialogue from within in addition to the total liberation of all the Sudanese lands from the hands of the rebellion in order to direct the money we spend on war to development. We are also working to structure the party.

Abdal-Rahim Mohammed Hisen – Khartoum State Governor:

My State is the most affected state by the war compare to other States. We did support the national dialogue with the aim to either win the war peacefully or militarily. The second problem we are facing is the resettlement and counting of the refugees from the South, Syria and Ethiopia. We have assigned the High Council for Strategic Planning by selecting the best experts with a high caliber to supervise the implementation of the reform charter. We are also working to restructure the NCP, the Islamic Movement and the guidance Council with the aim to create a crusader generation that is ready to sacrifice for the sake of religion and the country. All the training camps are open to increase the numbers of the police and other special forces intended to protect the national capital and its' strategic national installations.

Eisa Abbakar – South Kordofan Governor:

Despite the war situation, the implementation of the reform charter and development are going on well. We need more support from all the States with men and finance to enable the decision made by the State security committee to enter Kauda either peacefully or militarily, that because last year Adam Al-Faki managed to liberate 55 stations. We are determined to liberate each and every single piece of our land, all the factors are in our favor. We took measures to impose economic sanctions on the rebellion. We stopped trading with the rebels and warned those who supply the rebellion with food or fuel to be treated as enemies and that all their properties will be confiscated. We managed to conscript thousands of the sons of the displaced people and took them to RSF training camps, because they know the nature of the terrain of the area, while we pardon/ give amnesty to anyone who voluntarily returns from the rebellion.. The government must control the border with South Sudan.

Adam Al-Faki – South Darfur Governor:

We are faced by two problems in Darfur States, 1- Most Civilians are armed and they use these weapons in looting, theft and tribal conflicts 2- UNAMID forces also constitute/remains a burden to the States by interfering with the policies and affairs of the Darfur States. As Darfur governors, a joint agreement was made to deal with the administrative referendum that is likely organized to happen next April. we prepared the citizens in terms of what to say in the voting. The displaced camps and the NGOs poses direct threat to the National Security.

Dr. Hamid Siddiig – Islamic Movement:

The Islamic Movement will not hand-over power to anybody and we shall fight up to the last man. We will not surrender and we will not allow a formation of any transitional government. It's the Islamic Movement's idea to call for the national dialogue and the participation is free. those who are opposed to it should wait for the next elections. No consideration for the particularity of any State and we must crush the rebellion this year what so ever the cost. We are not going to succumb to any blackmailing or bargaining from anybody. There shall be no other force other than SAF in the country, and let SAF be ready to destroy the rebellion once and for all. Today the State is in its best status and if there is any foreign invasion we are all ready for martyrdom. It is only power that forces others to respect you.

Field Marshal/ Omer Al-Bashir – The President of the Republic:

The Islamic Movement is facing an internal conspiracy by the national Consensus Force and the Umma party, due to the splits they are suffering within their parties and the feeling that, they are finished and as a result considering us to be their enemies. They agreed with the rebels to divide Sudan after they have separated the South. But they don't know us who decided to separate the South because the cost of ruling it was high plus the heterogeneous composition of South Sudan population. We anticipated that if the South broke away, it will not continue as a State but split into small villages. The so-called SRF are no longer there in Darfur anymore and we shall chase/expel the UNAMID from Darfur against their will and They will leave Darfur on their own. We shall make it a hell to them and It is just a matter of time. On the other side we must collect all the guns from the hands of the civilians what so ever the cost, and the plan for that is ready. Regarding border problems we shall discuss it in the coming meeting of the National Security Council and the Defense Council in order to choose the appropriate means to tackle it. We have many options. Al-Sisi of Egypt is antagonistic to us because he has a feeling that we are against him. He is trying to provoke us, but we will not pay him any attention. We shall continue to support the Muslim Brothers and host them. Now all the students in Egypt started to come and study in Khartoum. We will not chase the Muslim Brothers for the sake of appeasing Al-Sisi or America. You as Governors have to assist them, provide them with security and investment opportunities. Al-Sisi will not be able to abolish the role of the Islamists and they will return with a full force to power and he will be forced to relinquish power. Regarding Fashaga we have talked to Desalign to solve this problem, he has a good relations with us and we are the ones who contributed to take them to power.

- For UNAMID we have many options.
- All what you said is agreed upon, and you have to continue with the general mobilization, open more training camps, arrange to avail food for the Mujahidiin , building the NCP as a party for the purpose of the liberation of the whole land from the hands of the rebellion peacefully or militarily. We want to see the national dialogue conference to reach a conclusion not for any thing tangible but to giving us the mandate and ground to convince the International and Regional Communities that, is the armed movements who are refusing to participate in the national dialogue. Then no constitutional conference or special consideration to a particularity of an area in Sudan.

Recommendations:

- We must use all means to evict UNAMID by the end of this year.
- Secure the resources in order to collect the guns from the tribes.

- Total liberation of the whole land from the hands of the rebels.
 - Ensure that, the National Dialogue conference comes out with a clear mandate to the President of the Republic.
 - Hosting the Islamists who flee Egypt and Syriya.
 - Arrange secure areas for the accommodation and harboring of the Islamists and ensure that they are properly concealed.
 - Holding talks with Ethiopia to sort out the problem of their militias.
 - Investigation to be conducted to find out whether the attacks on our farmers in Fashaga are deliberate and intended to drag us to a confrontation or not?
 - Deployment of regiments from SAF, PDF and police to monitor the border line with Ethiopia.
 - After the implementation of the agreement we have to coordinate with Dr. Riak Mashar Governors in Upper Nile States to help us monitor the border line.
 - We shall not hand over power to anyone and let us prepare ourselves for any unforeseen circumstances with the aim to maintain the gains of the Islamic Movement.
 - We should not go into conflict with Al-Sisi for the time-being.
 - After chasing the UNAMID and clearing the land from the rebels, we should create a trust for raising money to compensate the war victims of Darfur, so that, the families of the victims come out in front of the World in order to give up their rights with the ICC voluntarily.
 - You have to tighten the economic embargo on the rebels of the two areas.
 - Step up the general mobilization campaign and work to prepare the public opinion for the coming dry season military offensive.
